Students who intend to participate in athletics must see their principal immediately if:

- (1) They transfer from one school to another;
- (2) They change their residence while attending their current school;
- (3) They plan to transfer to another school without changing their address.

Failure on the part of an athlete to report his/her current legal residence or a change of residence to the principal of the school s/he is attending may result in:

- (1) Athletic ineligibility for the the athlete for at least one year;
- (2) Forfeiture of all contests/games won by the team on which the ineligible student played.
